# Copy Remote Change Project to Test Tenant

When copying an existing solution profile to a separate test tenant, in addition to implementation projects, you can now also choose change projects as the source. To find this option, in the Service Control Center, go to Systems and Service Requests Copy Solution Profile.

# **Evening Horizon**

SAP Business ByDesign now supports the dark mode theme called the Evening Horizon. This is available in addition to the default Morning Horizon theme. Please note that the Horizon theme has been now renamed to Morning Horizon.

You can change the default settings in My Settings Appearance Display.

# Intelligent Automation Functionality to be Provisioned by SAP Build Process Automation (BPA)

SAP Business ByDesign customers who are now going to scope Intelligent Automation functionality will be provisioned by the newest version of SAP Build Process Automation (BPA).

The new functionality is initially only released to customers who are not yet using Intelligent Robotic Process Automation (IRPA) for SAP Business ByDesign.

The automatic upgrade to BPA for the SAP Business ByDesign customers who are already using IRPA will take place later this year and users will be informed about the upgrade separately.

Alternatively, customers who are already using IRPA may consider upgrading manually to the new version of the product.

### Machine Learning Cockpit

#### SAP Delivered Scenario for Opportunity Success Prediction

In the Machine Learning Cockpit, you can now use the new sample scenario - **Opportunity Success** (CRM\_OPP\_SUCCESS), to predict if a CRM opportunity will be won or lost. As a key-user, you can use the sample scenario to create custom models and prediction runs to obtain the prediction percentage for that opportunity. The results of the prediction run are displayed automatically in the Opportunity document, with an option to update them directly if the fields have changed.

## OData Service to Read Organizational Management Data

You can now read the organizational (org) structure data using the new OData service organizationalmanagement. This service only supports the GET HTTP method. Using this service, you can fetch the org structure data as shown in the Org Structures view of the Organizational Management work center. You can access the service metadata from Application and User Management OData Services APOData Services organizationalmanagement.

### Changed Configuration of Telephone Attributes for Chile

The standard configuration of the telephone attributes for Chile have been changed.

The attribute Digit to be deleted when called from abroad has been changed from 0 to Empty.

The leading 0 will not be deleted automatically anymore if the number is formatted internationally.

### Region Code Updates According to ISO standard ISO 3166-2

The pre-delivered content for the regions that follows the standard ISO 3166-2 (deviations for some countries exist) has been updated due to an update by ISO.

## Manage Document Output History Report

A new report Manage Document Output History is now available. You can use this report to view the output history information for your business documents, including the business document context, output channel, output status, error, and system administration information.

As a key user, you can access this report from the Reports view of the following work centers:

# Resubmit and Retry Actions in Manage Document Output History Report

As a key user, you can now perform the following actions directly from the new Manage Document Output History report:

Retry and Print

- Retry and E-Mail
- Resubmit and Print
- · Resubmit and E-Mail

You can use the Resubmit action to resend already successfully submitted documents to print or e-mail directly from the report. You can use the Retry action to retry sending the documents with an error status to print or e-mail directly from the report.

These actions are supported only for the following document types:

- · Customer Invoice
- Supplier Invoice
- · Goods and Services Receipts
- · Delivery Notes

However, these actions are protected and, as a key user, you can perform these actions only if the following work center views are assigned to you:

- OUTPUT\_RETRY\_CUST\_INV: This work center view allows you to resubmit or retry Customer Invoice documents from the report.
- OUTPUT\_RETRY\_SUPP\_INV: This work center view allows you to resubmit or retry Supplier Invoice documents from the report.
- OUTPUT\_RETRY\_DELIVERY\_NOTES: This work center view allows you to resubmit or retry Delivery Notes from the
  report.
- OUTPUT\_RETRY\_GOODS\_SRV\_RCPT: This work center view allows you to resubmit or retry Goods and Services Receipts from the report.

#### i Note

Assigning these work center views does not restrict the user to any specific access context. If a work center view is assigned to you, then you can resubmit and retry all the documents from that work center. For example, if the customer invoice specific work center view is not assigned to you, but OUTPUT\_RETRY\_CUST\_INV is assigned, you can resubmit and retry any customer invoice document from this report.

Assigning these work center views is solely the Customer's responsibility. With this restriction, you can either resubmit and retry all the documents, or none, from that particular application.

## New Home Design (Controlled Availability)

You can now switch to the **New Home Design**. The **New Home Design** replaces the **Home** page and the **Home Overview** page of the **Home** work center into a new home page containing all the features of both the views at one place. This eases the need to switch back and forth between the home page and the home overview pages to view and work on your tasks.

You can switch to this feature by clicking the **New Home Design** on the **My Launchpad** view. You can switch back to the default Home design by clicking the same button. Please note that the key user adaptation mode is not yet supported on the Launchpad of new home design.

#### i Note

SAP must activate this option for you to be able to switch to the New Home Design.

# Discontinuing Integration between SAP Business ByDesign and SAP Subscription Billing

SAP will discontinue the support for the CPI-based integration between SAP Business ByDesign and SAP Subscription Billing. The integration content available on the SAP API Business Hub is deprecated and will be removed with the 2305 release. In case there is a business requirement, partners can offer an integration by leveraging the public APIs for both SAP Business ByDesign and SAP Subscription Billing.

Payment Purposes are now supported in the generation of payment files using XSL transformation.

You can include the payment purpose in the XSL transformation, using the PaymentMediumSpecificField GLO\_PAY\_PURPOSE.

# **Customer Language Adaptation Tool**

- The Customer Language Adaptation Tool is now enhanced to improve the translation coverage for the following when you log in with a custom language:
  - The type dependent tab header, status and document type, and the exception messages in the Supplier Invoicing work center.
  - The texts for document types, status, and additional information in the Document Flow user interface.

- Project and Time Management work centers
- A new functionality is now introduced to split large text pools into multiple small text pools to facilitate text pool export via MS Excel download.
- Custom Translation of Analytical Reports

# **Extended Authorization Support for Party Determination API**

For the Party Determination API **CRMDocumentPartyDeterminationV1** from SAP Cloud Application Studio reusable libraries (Partner Development Infrastructure), the authorization support has now been extended to technical users, along with the existing support for business users. Both business users and technical users can now use the API to obtain the determined parties for CRM documents, such as sales order, service order, service request, quote, contract, and customer return.

# **Define Workflow Rules for Price List Business Object**

You can now define workflow rules for the Price List business object and enable notifications or emails when specific field values have been changed, based on the defined conditions.

To create a workflow rule, go to Application and User Management Workflow Rules New. Select Price List from the Business Object field drop down and follow the standard process for workflow rule creation.

# What's New

# PSM Release in BO Purchase Ledger Account

The SetStatusToBeCleared action and QueryByElements query on the node LandedCostClearing of business object PurchaseLedgerAccount is now PSM enabled.

# Webservice ManageJournalEntryIn

The CreateBundle operation of the ManageJournalEntryln webservice is now enabled for Fund, Function, and Grant when public sector is scoped.

# **Deprecation of Payment Service Provider - Computop**

As communicated with the last release, the support for the point-to-point integration with Computop cannot be offered anymore and will be deprecated from the February 2023 release of SAP Business ByDesign. However, there will be no change for customers who are already using the point-to-point integration with Computop.

SAP Business ByDesign has been supporting point-to-point integration with very few payment service providers until now. This will be replaced by the SAP Digital Payments add-on which provides a central add-on, supporting multiple payment service providers out of the box, granting more flexibility and choice. Also, as SAP Digital Payments is integrated with many SAP products, there is only one central integration with the payment service provider.

# What Has Changed

The following functions have been changed:

## Preventing Tax Inconsistency When Clearing Down Payment Request

Clearing will not be possible if the sum of the transaction currency does not match the sum of the reporting currency made on the tax register entries for a down payment request. This is to prevent inconsistencies during tax computation.

## **Extraction Object for Open Items Receivables**

You can now create a new extraction object for Open Items Receivables using the Application and User Management Data Extraction work center view.

## **Enable Sequential Run for Allocation Mass Run**

Actual Costing Allocation run can now be enabled for sequential run from the backend. This will prevent data inconsistency caused by locking or period close errors.

# Trigger Re-valuation During Reversal of Manual JEV

Inventory Re-valuation is now triggered during the reversal process of Manual Postings.

### **Landed Costs - Cash Discount Scenarios**

The current limitation in payments is removed and during the reversal of payments with cash discounts that relate to landed costs, the discount amount now reflects correctly on the clearing set of the supplier invoices. This removes the need for a manual write-up/write-down journal entry in such a case.

## Fixed Assets Migration - Work Shift-Dependent Depreciation

During Fixed Asset Migration using the simple and extended template, there is an option now to enter the field Work Shift-Dependent Depreciation (Percent) from the template.

# Negative Balance in Journal Entry Error

Negative posting will not be allowed for journal entries, for the set of books, where negative posting is marked as not allowed.

# **PSM Release of Preceding Document**

The preceding document in the accounting notification has now been PSM released and is available to be used for partner development.

# Country/Region-Specific Changes

#### **Australia**

#### **Summary Layout Mapping Maintenance**

For Australia, the summary layout mapping entries maintenance has been opened in the **Tax Returns for Goods and Services - Australia** Business Configuration fine-tuning activity. The following changes have been done for the **Periodic GST Return** for Australia, which is a summary layout-based tax return. The **Add Row** button has been enabled. The **Valid From** and **Valid To** columns are now visible and the entries in the **Valid To** column can be edited.

#### **Austria**

#### Copying Existing Run

The New option of the EU OSS Tax Audit Report now includes a new field Create Tax Audit Report with Reference. Using this field you can create a new run by copying the contents of an existing run.

#### **Error Log**

On the view results screen, you can now check the errors by clicking the **Application Log** tab. The **Application Log** displays errors that indicate which transactions have violated constraints and business rules applicable to an XML.

#### Partner Enablement

In Austria, a new feature Enable Custom Audit Tax File for EU OSS Tax Report has been enabled to generate custom audit files for EU OSS Tax Audit Report in SAP Business ByDesign. This feature enables partners/customers to amend the tax audit file content and adapt audit files to relevant formats according to country-specific regulations.

#### Tax Details

EU OSS Tax Audit Report for Austria now includes a new section called Tax Details which displays the Tax Return ID.

For Italy, the following new tax code and tax event have been delivered for the purchase goods from non-EU countries with Reverse charge.

- Tax Event: NonEU Purchase, Reverse Charge
- Tax Code: NonEU Purchase, RevCharge, StndRate

#### **Summary Layout Mapping Maintenance**

For Italy, the summary layout mapping entries maintenance has been opened in the **Tax Returns for Goods and Services - Italy** Business Configuration fine-tuning activity. The following changes have been done for the **Summary Register** for Italy, which is a summary layout-based tax return. The **Add Row** button has been enabled. The **Valid From** and **Valid To** columns are now visible and the entries in the **Valid To** column can be edited.

#### Japan

#### **Summary Invoice**

It is now possible to create and post the tax difference for the Summary invoices created for the customer invoices with Gross pricing procedure.

#### Tax Codes for Non-Registered Supplier

**New Qualified Invoice** method (**TEKIKAKU SEIKYUHO**) will be introduced from October 1, 2023. In this case, you cannot deduct paid tax (purchase) from received tax (sales) if the supplier is not registered as a new qualified invoice issuer. On the other

hand, a transitional measure (partial percentage of paid tax amount can be deductible during the period October 1, 2023 to September 30, 2029) will be introduced to mitigate business impact to such non-registered suppliers.

The following tax codes have been delivered to differentiate supplier invoices by non-registered suppliers from other invoices.

- 063 Fixed asset taxable purch. for non-registered bus. (taxable sales)
- 064 Fixed asset taxable purch. for non-registered bus. (tax exempt sales)
- 065 Fixed asset taxable purch. for non-registered bus. (taxable & tax exempt sales)
- 153 Acqstn of svcs. for non-registered bus. rev. charge (taxable sales)
- 154 Acqstn of svcs. for non-registered bus. rev. charge (tax exempt sales)
- 155 Acqstn of svcs. for non-registered bus. rev. charge(taxable & tax exempt sale)
- 207 Import tax for non-registered bus. (Customs doc. taxable sales), stnd rate
- 208 Import tax for non-registered bus. (Customs doc. tax exempt sales), stnd rate
- 209 Import tax for non-registered bus.(Customs doc.-taxable & tax exempt sale), stnd
- 210 Import tax for non-registered bus. (Customs doc. taxable sales), reduced rate
- 211 Import tax for non-registered bus. (Customs doc. tax exempt sales), red. rate
- 212 Import tax for non-registered bus.(Customs doc.-taxable & tax exempt sale), red.

All above tax codes have been configured with a new deductibility code Partially Deductible with a tax rate of 80 % deductibility.

#### Mexico

#### New Withholding Tax Rate

For Mexico, the government has announced a new income withholding tax rate from January 1, 2022. The new tax rate is 1.25% and is calculated based on the net amount of the invoice. This new tax rate is applicable to individual supplier documents within the simplified trust regime (RESICO). New Withholding Tax Codes with VAT now include the VAT amount withheld in column 21 of the A-29 report.

#### **Netherlands**

#### Chain Liability

For the Netherlands, when payments are made as part of a payment run, the system now ensures that the correct bank account determination for g-accounts is made for a chain liability.

#### South Korea

#### **Electronic Tax Invoice**

In the Electronic Tax Invoice run for South Korea, a new tab Other Charge/ Credit has been added. During the execution of the E-tax Invoice run, the Other Charge/Credit listed in this section will be included along with invoices.

An Electronic Tax Invoice amendment is created when an Other Charge/ Credit is reversed in South Korea.

#### **Fixed Assets**

For South Korea, a new depreciation method: Declining-balance depreciation based on net book value (NBV) and planned useful life with a defined percentage. Depreciation method switches to straight line method in the last fiscal year.

#### **Total Trial Balance**

- The total trial balance can now be printed in PDF format in South Korea.
- It is now possible to determine in South Korea whether the Opening Balance should be included in the total trial balance calculation.
- It is now possible to maintain the financial structure under the new section **Common Master Data** in the total trial balance for South Korea.

#### New Tax Event and Tax Code

For Spain, a new tax event and tax code have now been delivered for non-deductible tax rate types.

- Tax Event: Acquisition by Travel Agencies under DA4
- Tax Code: 170- Acquisition by Travel Agencies under DA4

By defining workflow rules, you specify basic data for each rule such as the conditions under which the rule is invoked, and a field is updated.

New Association to ExpenseDocumentItemExpense

The ExpenseDocumentItemExpense association is now available from the CustomerProjectInvoiceRequest (root and item) to the ExpenseDocumentItemExpense node of the CustomerProjectExpenseList.

The association on item level shows the time and expense items that were assigned to this item.

On root level, you have to differentiate between these two cases:

If the project invoice request is in status Canceled, Invoiced, or Released, then all time and expense items are
included that were put on hold or written-off during the processing of the project invoice request.

• If the project invoice request is in status **Preparation**, then all time and expense items are included that still have an open amount to be invoiced and fall within the expense restriction period of the project invoice request. In this case, by changing the InvoiceItemID, time and expense items can be assigned to a project invoice request item.

This allows to create project invoice requests that use the time and material invoicing method and not only the fixed price invoicing method

#### **Blocked Indicator for Automatic Invoice Creation**

Using the EDIE node of the CPIR Root partners can use the **Blocked** indicator to define whether the respective time and expense item should be considered for the automatic creation of the project invoice request or not being processed at all.

## **Change Expense Restriction Period on Root Node**

As a partner, you can now change the expense restriction period on the root node of the project invoice request and therefore restrict the expenses that are assigned to a project invoice request using the new ExpenseDocumentItemExpense association.
